COVID-19 UPDATE

COVID-19 update: Due to the pandemic, Kiski closed the campus and offered remote classes for students from March-May of 2020. For the 2020-2021 school year, the School has introduced the "One Kiski" program, which allows students to attend classes on campus or to learn remotely through synchronous classes. Approximately 78% of our student body began the 2020-2021 school year on campus.
