As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, Stoneleigh-Burnham supports 135 boarding and day students in grades 7-12 from across the country and around the world. Twenty-eight faculty and staff members hold advanced degrees. The average class size is 10 students with a student to faculty ratio of 6:1.
