Wheat Center for Innovative Learning: The Wheat Center offers tutoring, skill-building, and academic support, and oversees our innovative postgraduate program, THRIVE, a unique year of study, internship, and travel.

River Program: Spanning the curriculum and residential life, our innovative River Program engages girls in hands-on science, outdoor adventures, and volunteer service.

Minimester and Independent Study: Students take enrichment courses or go on educational trips during a twoweek winter term, while seniors conduct research or intern in a field of potential career interest.

Leadership: Social responsibility is promoted here and inspires students to serve as Chapel leaders, on our Honor Council, in Student Government, and to volunteer in our local community and around the world.
